




4X4 ROUND POUCH UNLINED TUTORIAL



Supplies needed:

- (3) 5 in. Square Fabric Pieces
- Fold 2 of the pieces in half and press. Leave one unfolded.
- Cutaway Stabilizer
- Zipper
- Small Piece of Ribbon for Tab or Key Fob Hardware if using instead of a tab




- Hoop your cutaway stabilizer.



- Run Step 1: Placement stitch for your Pouch and Zipper..



- Line up your zipper, using the stitch line guide to center.



- Tape your zipper down well.



- Run Step 2. This will tackdown the top half of the zipper.



- Run Step 3. This will tackdown the bottom half of the zipper.



- Remove the tape from your zipper.



- Lay down one of your folded fabrics with the fold butting up against the Top half of your zipper.
- Run Step 4. This will tackdown your Top Front Piece.



- It will look like this after running Step 4.



-Lay down your other Folded piece of fabric, with folded edge butting up against the zipper.
-Run Step 5. This will tackdown your bottom front piece.



- Run Step 6. This is your placement for the tab.
- If you are not using a tab, skip this step.




- Lay your ribbon piece down, folded edge towards the inside pointing towards the zipper. Raw edges pointing out.
- Tape to secure and run Step 7.



- **IMPORTANT STEP!!!! OPEN YOUR ZIPPER ABOUT HALF WAY....**




- Lay your unfolded piece of fabric on top right sides together.
- Run Step 8. This will attach your front sand back pouch pieces.



- Remove from hoop and loosely cut around square to have a more manageable piece to do your final trimming.



- Trim around the entire pouch leaving a little extra seam allowance at the zipper ends.



- Carefully trim out the stabilizer so you can access the zipper.



- Open your zipper, carefully and pull the pouch right side out through the zipper opening.
- Press carefully and you are all done! Enjoy!
