



## BLANK APPLIQUE CAR COASTER TUTORIAL

\*\*\*Sample used is the Blank Appliqué Car Coaster.



### Supplies needed:


- 3 in. Square Piece of Vinyl for the Base  
*(4" if making LARGE)*
- 3 in. Piece of Water Proof Canvas, Vinyl, or Felt for Backing of Coaster  
*(4" if making LARGE)*
- Small Scrap of Fabric or Vinyl for center Appliqué



- Hoop your cutaway stabilizer.



- Run Step 1: Placement stitch for your Vinyl Base.



- Lay down your Main Vinyl for the base of your Car Coaster and tape to secure.



- Run Step 2. This is the placement stitch for your center appliqué piece.



- Lay down your appliqué fabric. Tape to secure.



- Run Step 3. This will Tackdown your appliqué fabric. Even though it is taped down, I kinda use my fingers to make sure the fabric stays flat and doesn't bubble up in middle.



- This is what it looks like after the tackdown runs.



- Pull up the tape off of the appliqué fabric.




- Trim closely around your appliqué fabric. I like to start in the corner by the little indent. Trim all the way around as close as you can, be very careful not to snip your stitches.



- This is what it should look like before the next step. Make sure there are no loose threads or fuzzies before running the satin.



- Run Step 4. This will run the decorative Satin Stitch.



- Flip your Hoop over and trim any loose threads.



- On the backside of the hooped stabilizer, tape down your backing piece to secure.



- Put your hoop back in and Run Step 5. This will attach your Front and Back Pieces of your coaster.



- Trim carefully around your coaster. I like to start in the corner by the indent for a clean finish.



- What it will look like after it's all trimmed up! All Done! Enjoy!!!
