




4X4 ROUND POUCH LINED TUTORIAL



Supplies needed:

- (3) 5 in. Square Pieces of Main Fabric for Exterior of Pouch
- (3) 5 in. Square Pieces of Liner Fabric for the Interior of the Pouch
- Cutaway Stabilizer
- Zipper
- Small Piece of Ribbon for Tab or Key Fob Hardware I using instead of tab




- Fold two of your Main Fabrics in half and press.
- Fold two of your Liner Fabrics in half and press.
- Hoop your stabilizer.



- Run Step 1. This is your placement stitch for the pouch and the zipper.



- Line up your zipper, using the stitched line guide to center.



- Tape your zipper down well.



- Run Step 2. This will Tackdown your top half of your zipper.
- Run Step 3. This will touchdown your bottom half of your zipper.



- Remove the tape from your zipper.
- Lay down one of your folded fabrics with the fold butting up against the Top half of your zipper.
- Run Step 4. This will tackdown your Top Exterior Piece.




- Lay down your other Folded piece of fabric, with folded edge butting up against the zipper.
- Run Step 5. This will tackdown your bottom Exterior piece.



- Run Step 6. This is your placement stitch for the tab.
- If you are not using a tab, skip this step.



- Lay your ribbon piece down, folded edge towards the inside pointing towards the zipper. Raw edges pointing out.
- Tape to secure and run Step 7. This will tackdown your tab.



- Flip your hoop over. Place one of your folded liner pieces using the stitched line guides, and secure with tape.



- Put your hoop back in machine.
- Run Step 8. This attaches the top Interior Piece.
- This is what the front and back should look like.
- Remove the tape from the backside.




- On the backside of the hoop, Place your other folded liner piece down and secure with tape.
- Use the stitched lines as a guide for placement.
- Run Step 9.
- This attaches your bottom Interior Piece.



-IMPORTANT STEP!!!! OPEN YOUR ZIPPER ABOUT HALF WAY....



- Lay your unfolded piece of Main Exterior fabric on top right sides together.
- Run Step 10.
- This will attach the Back Exterior Piece.



- Flip your hoop over.
- Lay your unfolded piece of Back Liner fabric on your already stitched front liner pieces right sides together.



- Secure well with tape.



- Run Step 11. It will stitch an “incomplete” circle. This is what the front and the backside of your hoop should looklike after that step. There will be an opening to turn your pouch through.



- Trim around the pouch, leaving extra seam allowance at the open end. You will need a bit of extra fabric for hand stitching the opening closed, after turning back through the zipper.
- Also leave a little extra seam allowance at the zipper ends.



- Carefully trim out the stabilizer so you can access the zipper.



- Open your zipper, carefully and pull the pouch right side out through the zipper opening
- Press carefully and you are all done! Enjoy!
