



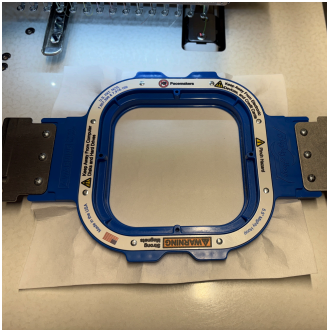
## BLANK APPLIQUE ORNAMENT TUTORIAL

\*\*\*Sample used is the Oval Horizontal Blank Appliqué Ornament. But the technique can be used for any appliqué design needing a template.



### Supplies needed:

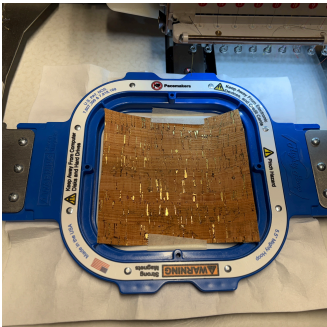
- Cutaway Stabilizer (I used 3.5oz)
- Base Vinyl for Ornament (I used cork)
- Fabric or Printed Vinyl for the appliqué
- Backing Fabric or Vinyl (I used Felt)
- Eyelet
- Ribbon



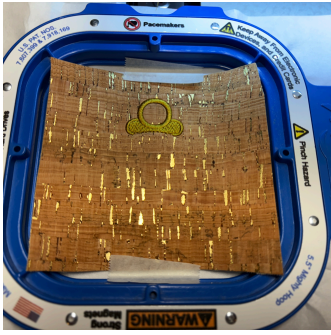
- Hoop your cutaway stabilizer.



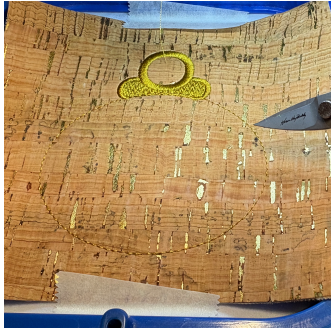
- Run Step 1: The Main vinyl ornament placement stitch.



- Lay down your Main Vinyl or the base of your ornament and tape to secure.



- Run Step 2. This is the Ornament hanger at the top.



- Run Step 3. This is your Appliqué Placement stitch.



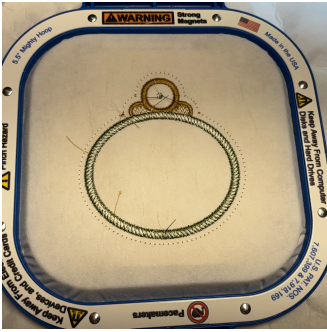
- Lay your fabric or your printed vinyl down and secure with tape.



- Run Step 4. This is your fabric tackdown stitch. You will trim carefully up to the stitch line making sure not to snip any of your stitches.



- After Trimming, Run Step 5. This will be the decorative Satin around the edges. And next run Step 6. This will be your eyelet Placement.



- Flip over your hoop.



- Secure your Backing for your ornament with tape and return to machine.



- Run the final Step 7. This will stitch the backing fabric to your Ornament.



- Remove from your hoop, cut down to a manageable size, before doing final trimming. Trim Carefully around the entire ornament.

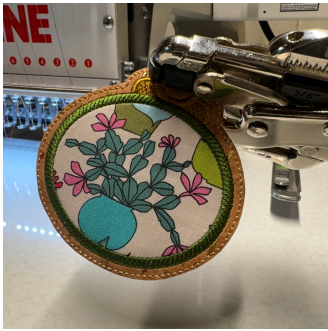


- Punch your eyelet hole.





- Place your eyelet in.



- Crimp your eyelet.



- Add a ribbon! I like to add a bow and bell to all my ornaments.
