



Scallop Gift Card Holder Tutorial

Supplies Needed:

- *Wash Away Stabilizer. (I use Superpunch Wash Away Stabilizer, SuperStable H2O "Eau" Gone. Available on Amazon)
- *3.5" x 5" Front Vinyl
- *3.5" x 5" Back "Front Facing" accent Vinyl
- *3.5" x 5" Back Vinyl




Directions:

- *Hoop Heavy or Mesh Washable stabilizer. Not the super flimsy plasticy stuff, or one with adhesives.
- *Run step 1 placement stitch on the stabilizer

*Lay down 3.5" x 5" front vinyl face up. Run step 2 will just be a bean stitch running where the top of the pocket opening will be.




*Run all embroidery design elements

* Keep project in the hoop. Trim all loose threads and tails front and back. Trim carefully along the "V" stitch line.



*Flip over secure 2 pieces of vinyl to the back side of the hooped stabilizer with tape. These two vinyl pieces will be wrong side together, Accent Vinyl right side against the stabilizer. The Back vinyl piece will be right side facing out like normal back on our ITH projects.




*Return Hoop to the machine. Match bobbin and top thread. Run Last two steps to secure the backing and the placement stitch for the eyelet



*Remove hoop. Trim away any stabilizer you can see to help minimize gummy-ness. Rinse off rest of stabilizer using a Q-tip or I like a toothbrush to go around the opening to release the stitches on the pocket.

*Trim around outside of your card holder.

*Attach eyelet and embellish how you like
